

**Exploring Disparities in Development
between an EU Country (Ireland) and an
EU Candidate Country (Turkey)**

Student Formative Assessment

Candidates will have the opportunity to select from a range of questions. These questions will relate to disparities between countries or disparities within a country. Some questions may require candidates to draw labelled sketch maps and/or diagrams, as well as providing a written explanation. Other questions may be based on a written answer, but candidates are encouraged to include sketch maps and/or diagrams to support their answer.

Assessment will focus on:

- the use of objective indicators in explaining the differences in levels of development (the problems associated with these indicators as a measure of development)
- the ways in which natural factors contribute to disparities.

In the final examination, this achievement standard will be worth **three credits**.
